CERTIFICATE OF RELIGIOUS KNOWLEDGE (CertRK)

The CertRK is a Bible study programme at the basic level. The successful completion of 20 credits earns the CertRK. This may be achieved through:

- (1) One to two semesters of full-time residential studies at FEBC.
- (2) Two to three years of evening classes on Monday and Thursday nights (7.30 pm-9.30 pm) at FEBC.
- (3) A combination of evening and distance learning courses.

CERTIFICATE OF BIBLICAL STUDIES (CertBS)

The CertBS is a Bible study programme at the advanced level. The successful completion of 40 credits (or 20 credits beyond the CertRK) earns the CertBS. This may be achieved through:

- (1) Two to three semesters of full-time residential studies at FEBC.
- (2) Four to five years of evening classes on Monday and Thursday nights (7.30 pm-9.30 pm) at FEBC.
- (3) A combination of evening and distance learning courses.

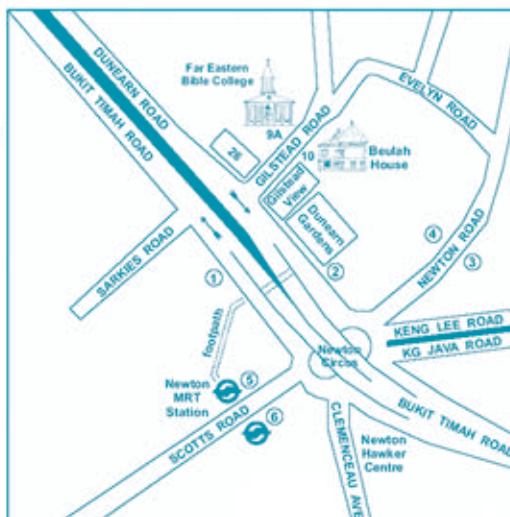
