

URGENT WARNING TO GOD'S FAITHFUL PEOPLE IN OUR BP CHURCHES

“DIRECTION AND END OF THE CURRENT REBELLION BY THE MANDARIN LEADERS OF CALVARY PANDAN AGAINST THE BOARD OF ELDERS OF CALVARY PANDAN BP CHURCH”

STATEMENT OF FACT

From my 60 years' observation and experience I say, the present wave of attack against God's Word by Rev Tang and his allies is a departure from our BP Stand of “Biblical Separation” and will eventually lead to “falling away” and apostasy.

TIME WILL TELL.

1. **On 8 July 2007**, Rev Tang released 4 papers by which he aligned himself with
 - a) persons who have undeniable ecumenical and new evangelical connections and sympathies
 - b) persons who use/promote corrupt Modern English Versions of the Bible
 - c) persons who believe the Bible has mistakes
 - d) persons who, like himself, attack the God-honouring stand of VPP

This is a serious violation of our Church Constitution 6 of **Biblical Separation**.

2. **On 18 August 2007** Rev Tang threatened Dr Tow and Calvary Pandan's Board of Elders, saying: *“Those who teach VPP must be stopped from doing so, or else they should leave this church and set up another church to promote VPP, like what True Life BPC and Truth BPC have done.”*

THIS IS LIKE AS A SON, NURTURED MANY YEARS BY A BENEVOLENT MOTHER, NOW BIG AND STRONG, THREATENING THE MOTHER, “GET OUT IF YOU DO NOT DO AS I SAY”

3. **On 16 March 2008** Rev Tang released a 60-page Paper, “WHY WE DO NOT ACCEPT THE DOCTRINE OF VERBAL PLENARY PRESERVATION (VPP).”

CALVARY PANDAN BOE HAS REJECTED THE PAPER AS UNTRUE AND DECEPTIVE.

4. **THE DIRECTION TAKEN BY REV TANG AND SESSION POINTS TOWARD ECUMENICISM, NEW EVANGELICALISM, CORRUPT MODERN ENGLISH BIBLES, EVENTUALLY – APOSTASY. DEVALUING KJV, ALLOWING MODERN ENGLISH BIBLES, WILL LEAD TO UNSTOPPABLE FALLING AWAY. HISTORY WILL REPEAT ITSELF. TIME WILL TELL.**
