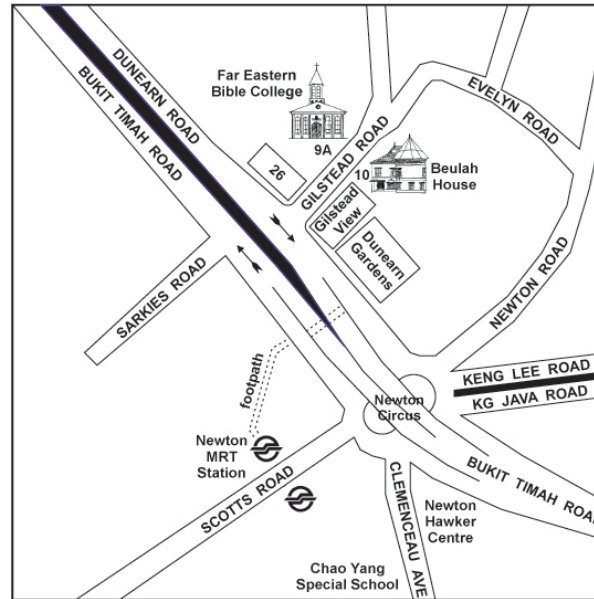
Many are confused over what tithes and offerings mean and what they are for. Without a right understanding of giving, many sincere Christians might be giving sinfully without realising it.

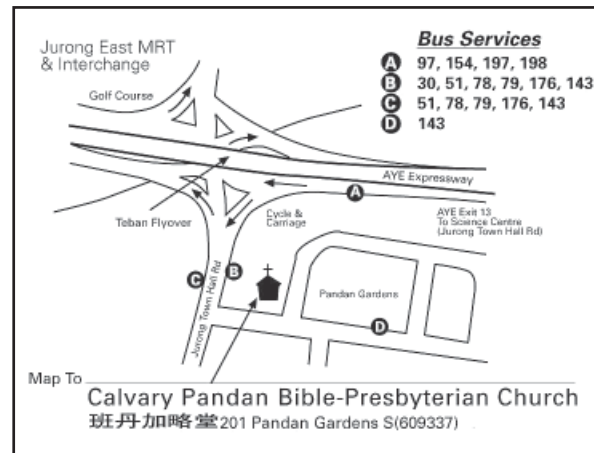
